BACKGROUND SUMMARY	Edward Laughlin is a suspected brother to Michael Laughlin, who was the father of Catherine Laughlin – an emigrant from County Galway, Ireland. The Laughlin families landed in Pennsylvania before making their way to McHenry, Illinois and then onward to Steele and Le Sueur Counties in Minnesota. Information used in conjunction with <i>Ancestry.ca</i> tree “[PRIVATE]” by [LIVING], and personal genealogy notes provided by [LIVING], including oral history and stories provided by Sister Shaun O’Meara. ¹

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS:

The research objective for this session has been met.

Donald Laughlin, Gambling Entrepreneur, who founded “Laughlin, Nevada” is the GGgreat-grandson of Edward Laughlin and Catherine Madden. I have shown in the following report a detailed investigation leading to this path of his ancestry.

Following the chain of BMD (birth, marriage, death) records as well as census and newspaper articles, I have pieced together the ancestral chart for Edward Laughlin and his descendants.

The relationship of Donald Laughlin being a son of Raymond Patrick Laughlin is shown on several census reports showing him living in the household and having a son/parent relationship noted. Raymond Patrick Laughlin met with a tragic accidental death at age 45. In contrast, as of 2023, his son Donald is living into his 90s.

This report may be used in conjunction with additional Laughlin reports done for:

The four *probable* Laughlin brothers are: Edward, Patrick, John, and Michael – the latter of whom is Catherine’s father, who died circa 1858 in the Atlantic Ocean while immigrating with his family. I have a pedigree for each of these Laughlin families, as well as a Madden pedigree showing possible siblings who married into the Laughlin clan.

Unfortunately, I have not been able to locate birth information for Edward Laughlin showing where he was born in Ireland. This person is one of interest and I will continue to research (as time allows on a pro bono status) as new records become scanned and available from Ireland, and you will be notified.

A little history about the surname of Laughlin:

O MAOILSHEACHLAINN – O Mulshaghlen, O Melaghlin, (MacLaughlin, MacLoughlin, O'Loughlan, O'Loughlin); 'descendant of Maolsheachlainn' (servant of St. Secundinus); the name of a once celebrated Meath family, of the race of Niall of the Nine Hostages, who derive their descent from Maelsheachlainn, or Malachy II, King of Ireland, who was dethroned by Brian Boru and died in the year 1022. The clan-name of the O Melaghlin and their co-relatives was Clann Cholmain. Before the Anglo-Norman invasion they were kings of Meath, but after that period their power greatly declined. Meath was granted to Hugh de Lacy, and for many centuries the O Melaghlin were confined to the barony of Clonlonan in Westmeath. They were, however, one of the five Irish families who had the privilege of using English laws. In the reign of James I they were again stripped of a considerable portion of what remained of their ancient patrimony; and so completely had this ancient and once powerful family been ruined by the confiscations of the 17th century that in the attainders of 1691 there appears to be one person of the name, Maolseachlin O Melaghlin, of Lough Mask, Co. Mayo. The name is now everywhere disguised under the anglicised forms of MacLaughlin, MacLoughlin, etc.

The surname MacLaughlin, also spelt Laughlin, Lauchlan, Laughlan, MacLoughlin and McLaughlin, is used in modern Irish as the Anglicization of an Old Gaelic name borne by two entirely distinct Gaelic sept, the first originally called 'O' Maoilsheachlann' and Anglicized as O'Melaghlin up to the end of the 17th Century assumed the name MacLoughlin in circa 1691. The territory of this sept lay in the central plains of Ireland, especially in County Meath. The Gaelic prefix "O" indicates male descendant of, and "maol", the tonsured one, i.e. a devotee (of Saint Seachlann i.e. St. Secundinus). This Maoilsheachlann from whom the family descends was better known as Malachy II, High King of Ireland from 980 - 1002. The second MacLaughlin sept belonged to Innishowen Co. Donegal. The name means "son of (mac) Lochlann", a compound of the Norse elements "loch", a lake or fjord, plus "lann" land. The great leading men of this sept are frequently referred to in "The Annals of the Four Masters". Among the recordings in Ireland is the marriage of John

McLaughlin and Elizabeth Crauffurd on June 23rd 1666 at Derry Cathedral, Templemore, Londonderry, Northern Ireland. The first recorded spelling of the family name is shown to be that of MacLochlann of Ulster, which was dated circa 1200, in the Annals of Medieval History (Counties Donegal and Derry), during the reign of King Cathal, Craobhdhearg - known as Red Hand, High King of Ireland, 1198 - 1224. Surnames became necessary when governments introduced personal taxation. In England this was known as Poll Tax. Throughout the centuries, surnames in every country have continued to "develop" often leading to astonishing variants of the original spelling.

MacLaughlin, MacGloughlin, Melaghlin.

The MacLoughlin family name in Ireland may stem from one of two completely independent septs. When shortened to "Loughlin" or Laughlin, some confusion may exist as to whether the original name was O'Loughlin or MacLoughlin.

One family descends from O Maoilsheachlainn, and they were known as O'Melaghlin into the 18th century. They descend from Malachy II, King of Ireland (d. 1002 a.d.), who fell to the powers of the great Brian Boru. The name is said to mean follower of Seachlainn, i.e. St. Secundinus. The Norman invasions of the 12th century mark the families continued decline from power. The family in more modern times was found as McLoughlin in Meath.

The second family of the name stems from MacLochlann, (son of Lochlainn), of the northern Ui Neill in Innishowen, Co. Donegal. They are prominent in Co. Derry as well. The spelling of MacGloughlin is also used in Dublin today. They began to decline in power in the middle of the 13th century. A branch of this family settled in Leitrim under the leadership of the O'Rourke clan, and it is so recorded in the Composition Book of Connacht.

McLaughlin was the preferred spelling of the name in 1891, with some 191 births recorded mainly in Antrim, Donegal, Londonderry, Tyrone and Dublin. McLoughlin had 170 births recorded in various locations.

"The MacLaughlins or Clan Owen, was published by T. P. Brown in Boston, in 1879.

Traditionally known as Lords of the Burren, this name comes from Co. Clare, the county which has always been the center of O'Loughlin country.

Lochlain (A.D. 953) is the man from whom the name is taken. Originally from the same clan as the O'Connors, two brothers split the clan with one forming the O'Loughlins and the other the O'Connors in the 10th century.

Corcomroe was the area inhabited by this family, and they ruled over the area known as the Burren, meaning the "Rocky Place."

O'Loughlin retained all of the Burren until the invasions of Cromwell. The occupiers remarked that the Burren, "had not enough water to drown a man, wood enough to hang him, nor dirt enough to bury him. This statement may have been true then, but the O'Loughlins thrive there to this day none the less.

Early O'Loughlin ancestors may have come from northern Ireland, and may not be an ancient Dalcassion sept. An ancient Dane or Viking heritage is also possible stemming from the possible word origins of "Lochlainn", a word used to describe the same. MacLoughlin is an entirely separate family.

Most powerful on the shores of the Atlantic and Galway Bay in earlier times, the Burren is still the heart of O'Loughlin country today.

Family researchers take note of the "History and Topography of County Clare" by J. Frost, Dublin 1883, and the "O'Loughlin Book", Irish Genealogical Foundation, Kansas City, 1981. The former work contains hundreds of the name not found in its index.

Another family used the name anciently, they were near Dublin, and are cited as Kings of Ireland.

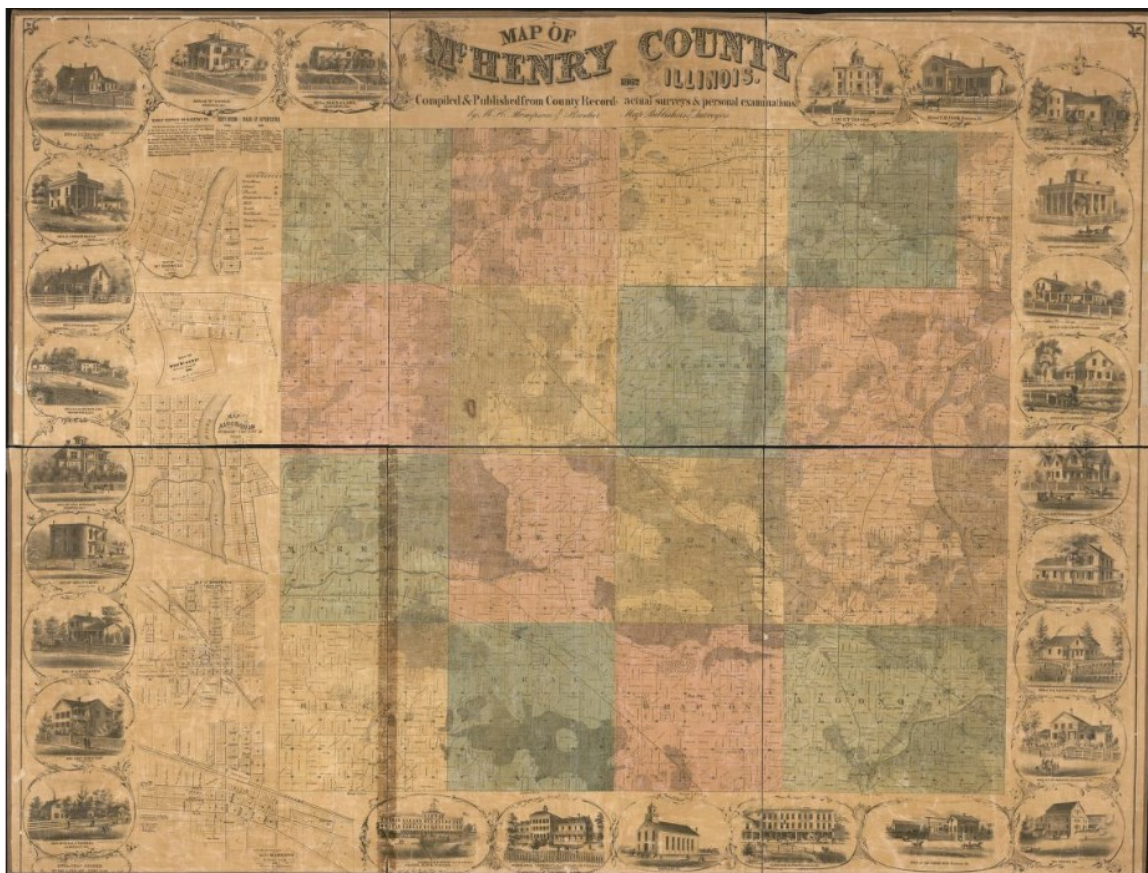

From Glenn's notes: "I was conducting research on the Patrick Madden Jr Property where I believe the Laughlin's stayed for 3 years, from 1858 – 1861 before moving to Steele County MN. I did not locate a property owned by Mary Laughlin or her son so I believed she lived on or near the Patrick Madden Jr Property 1858 – 1861. As you can see by the dwelling numbers, they are very close together, albeit I am comparing an 1860 Census to an 1862 plat map/atlas."

To expand upon these notes, we now know there was Edward Laughlin living in the area at this time. If he and Michael Laughlin were brothers, that would indicate perhaps another scenario that Mary (Lang) Laughlin lived, if she was not with Patrick Madden.



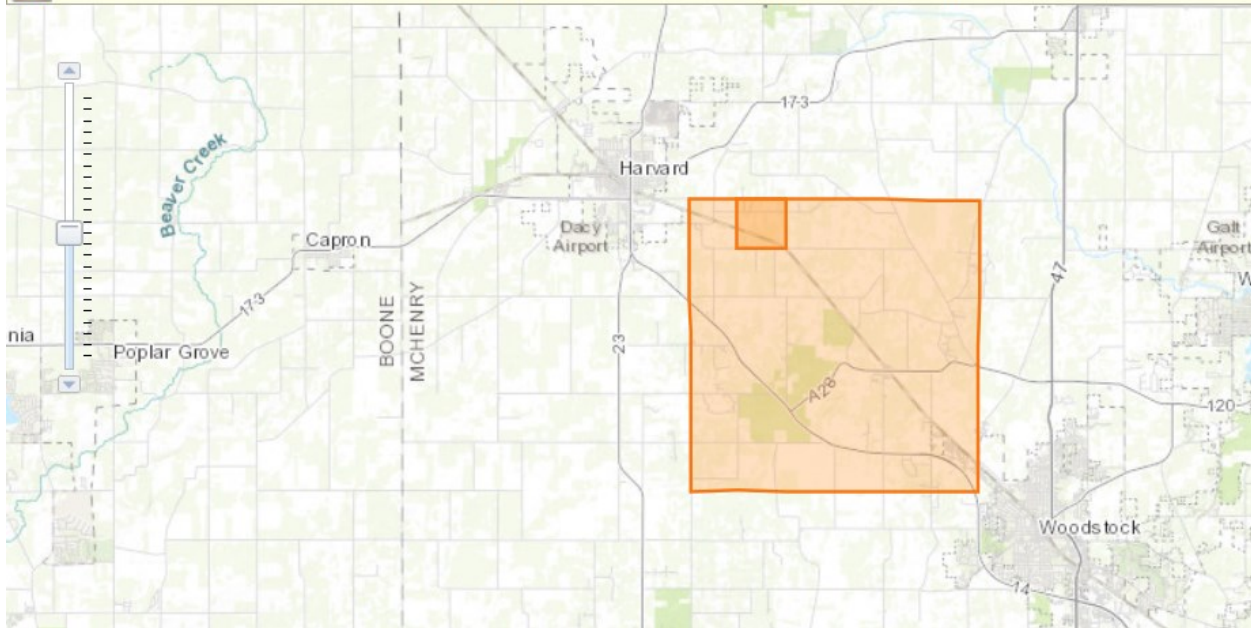


Figure 6: Closeup of 1862 map (full map previous), showing Madden and Laughlin lands adjacent

Figure 7: Closeup of 1872 map (full map next page) showing several Laughlin and Madden properties

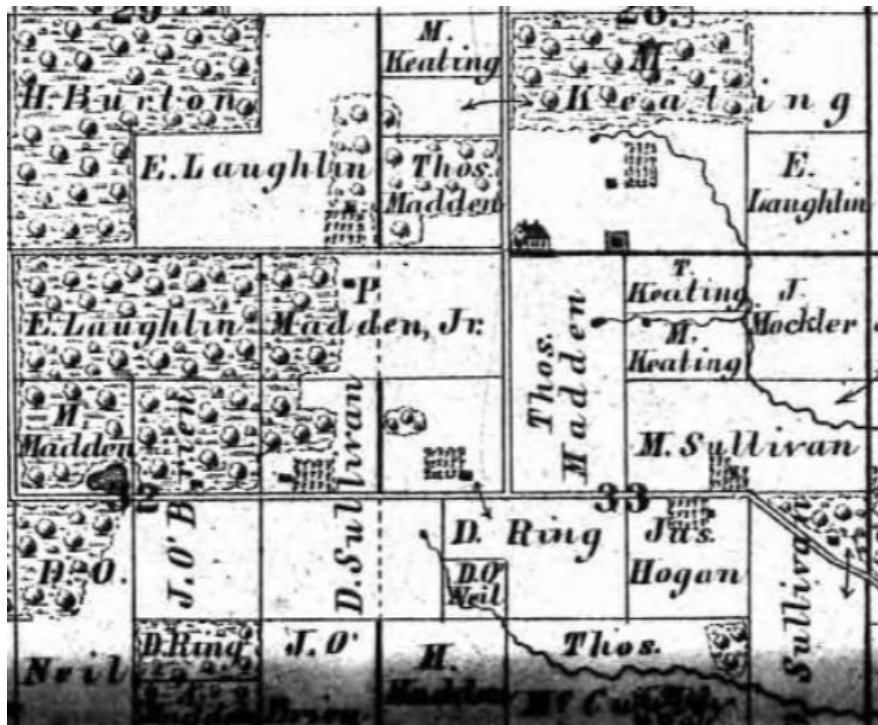


Figure 8: 1872 map of Alden township showing land ownership. Laughlin and Madden properties are in lower bottom left corner of map.

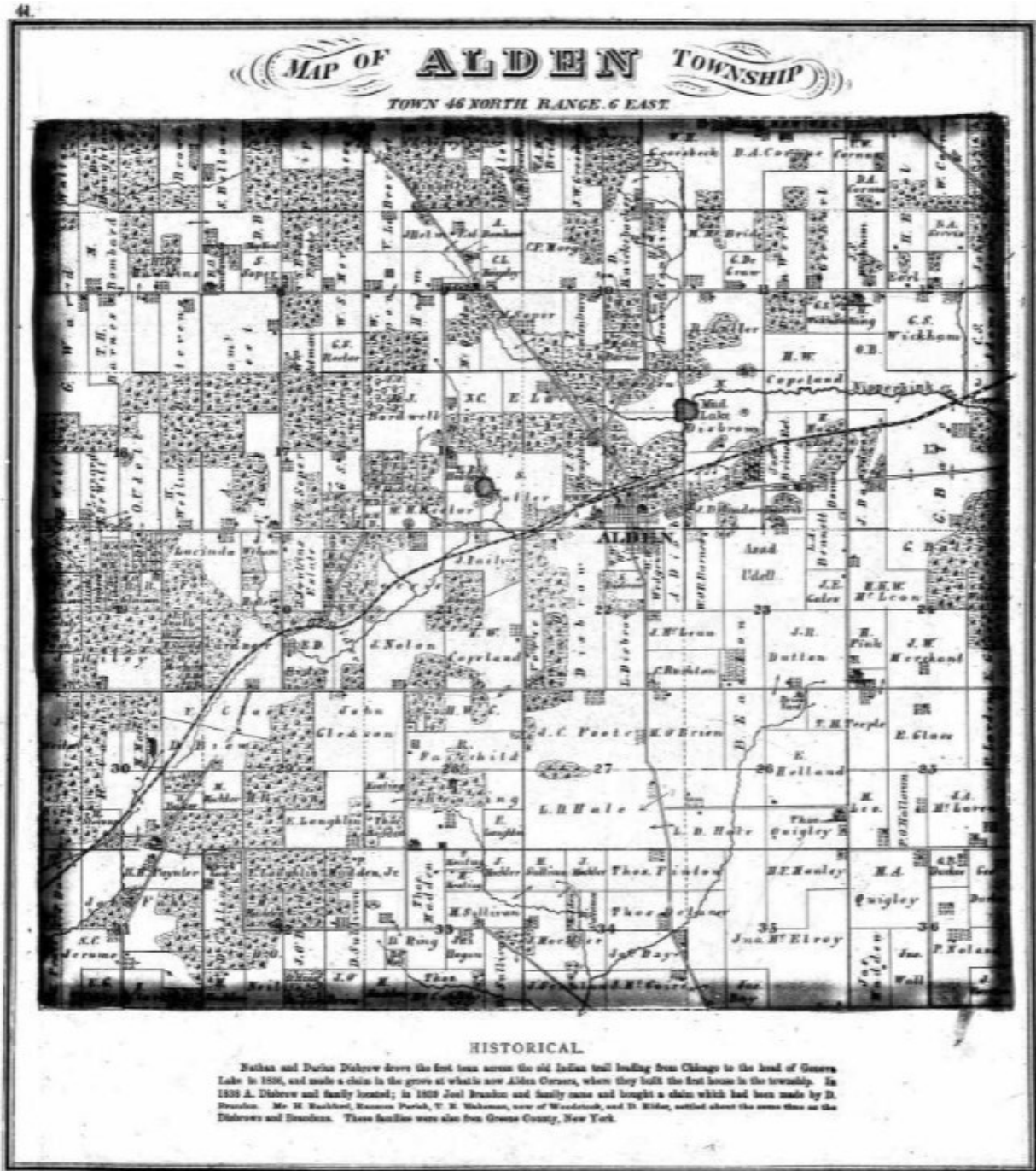


Figure 9: Patrick, Patrick Jr., and Michael Madden land records:

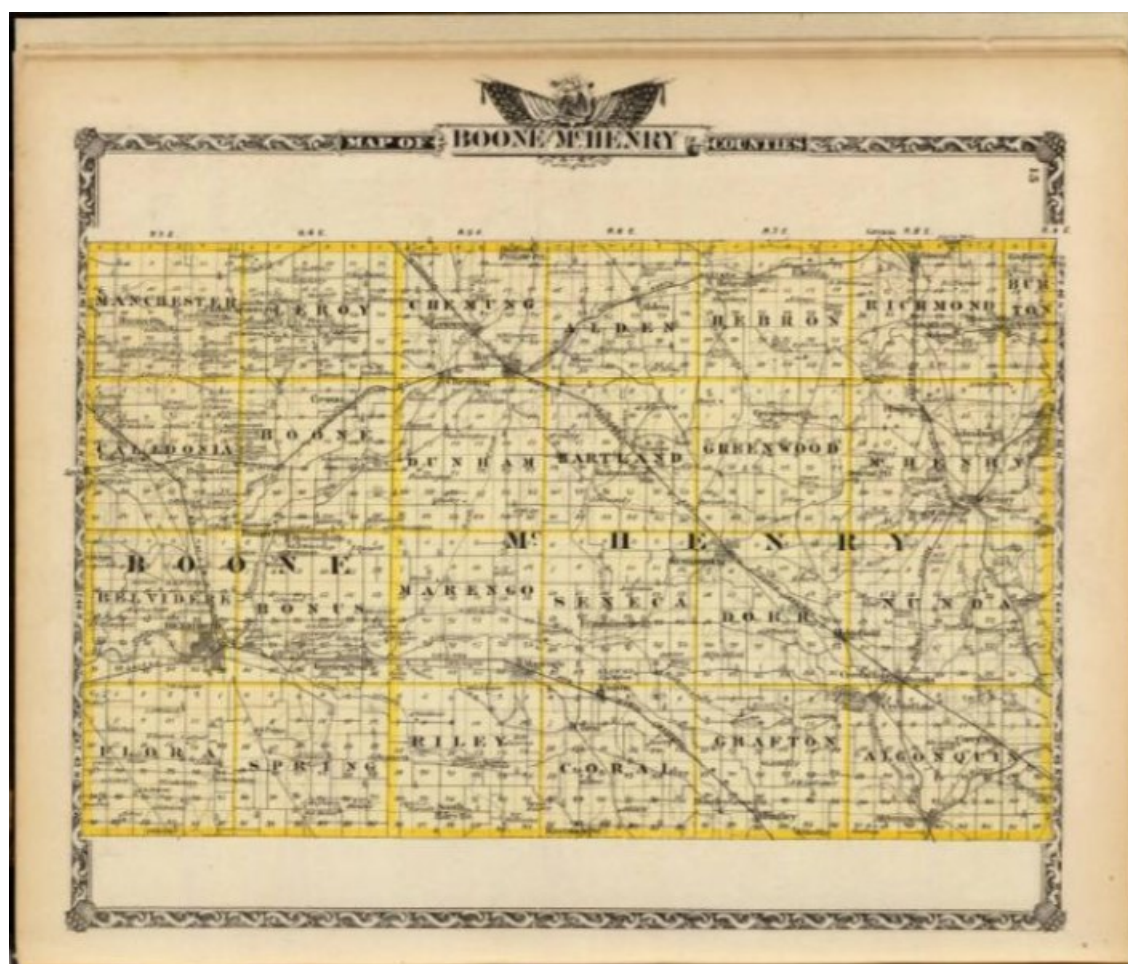
Figure 10: For Patrick Madden in the township of Alden, section 32:

Figure 11: 1876 Map of Boone and McHenry Counties:

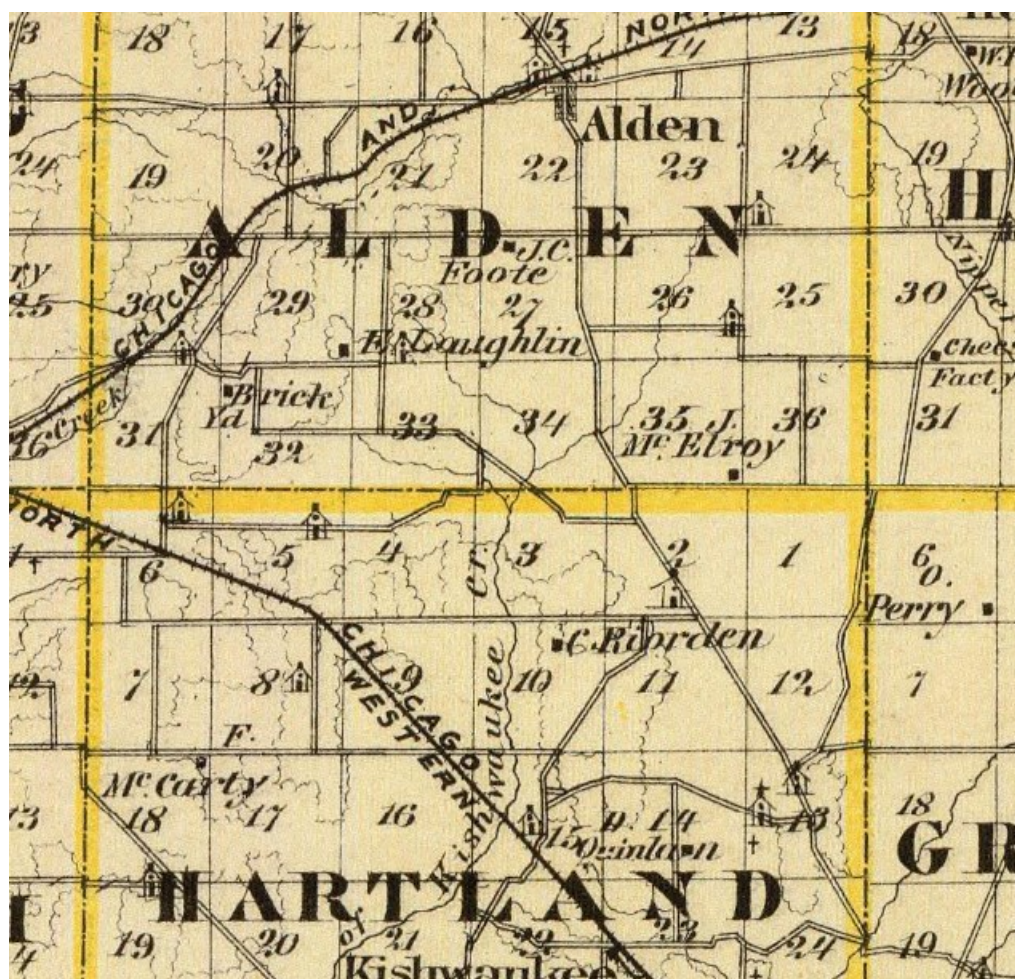

Figure 13: 1866 Map of Minnesota, showing Steele County at center

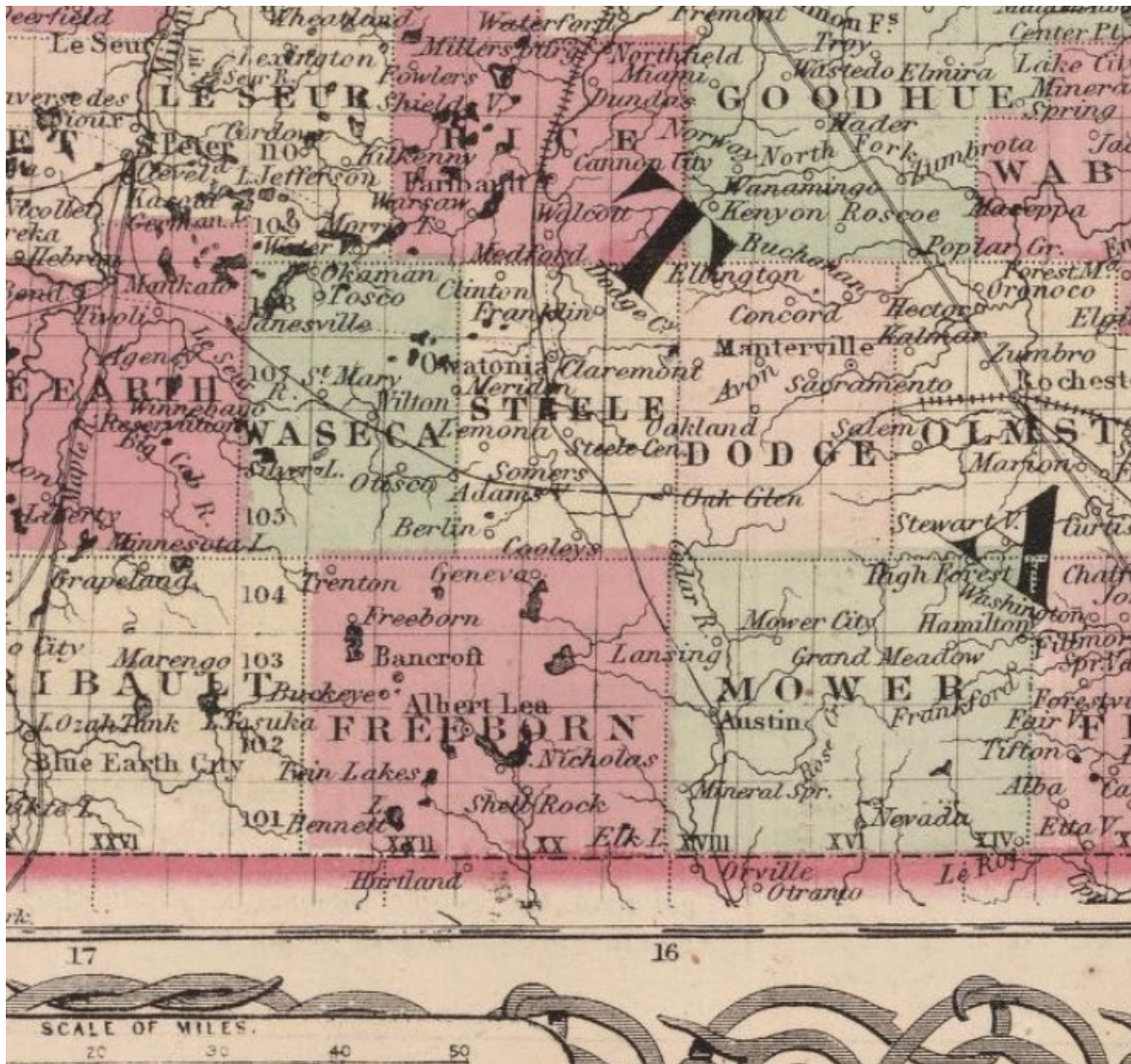
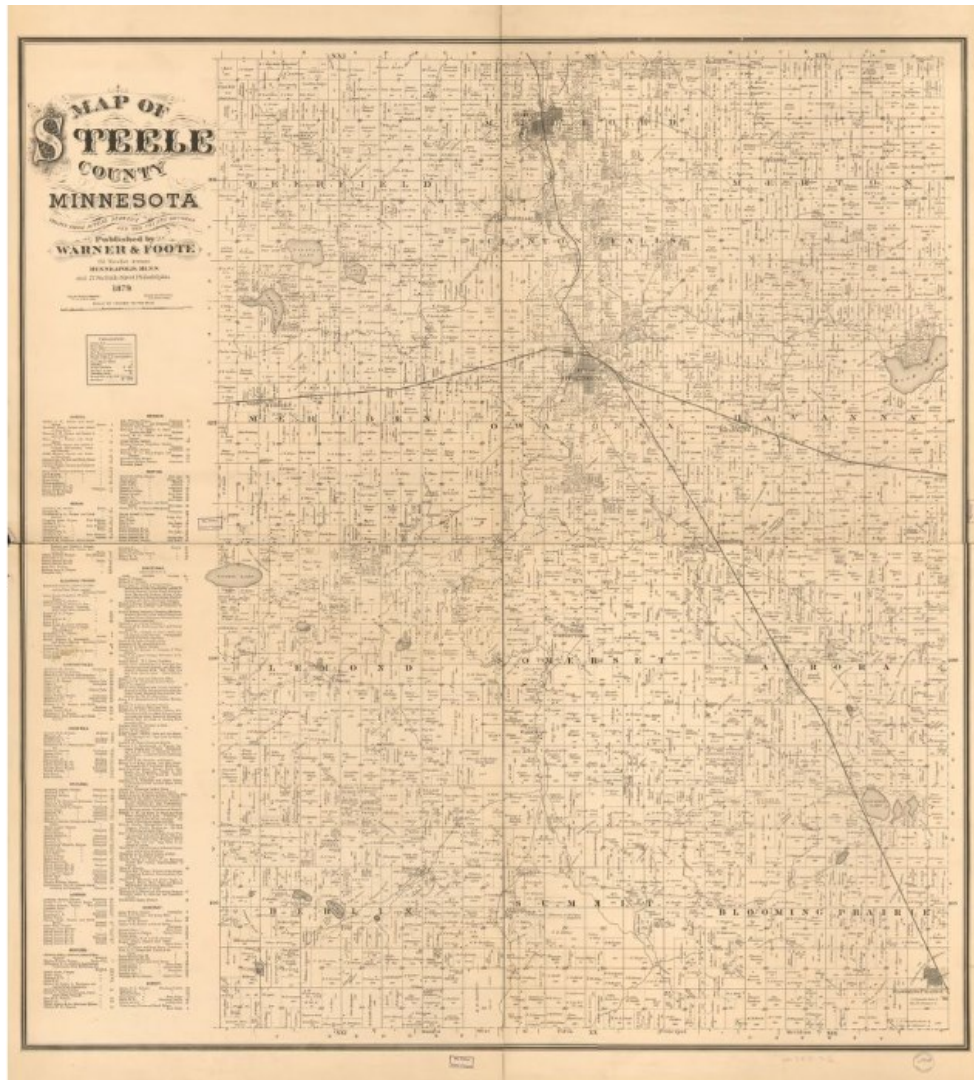


Figure 14: 1872 Map/ Atlas of Steele County, Minnesota:

Figure 15: Closeup of 1872 map of Section 31-33 in Merton/Havana townships

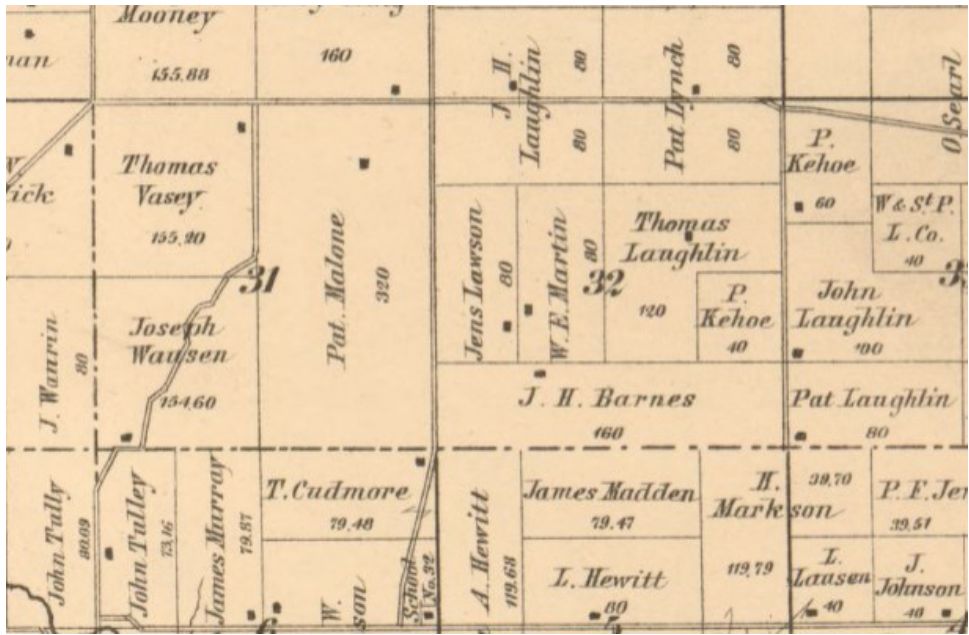
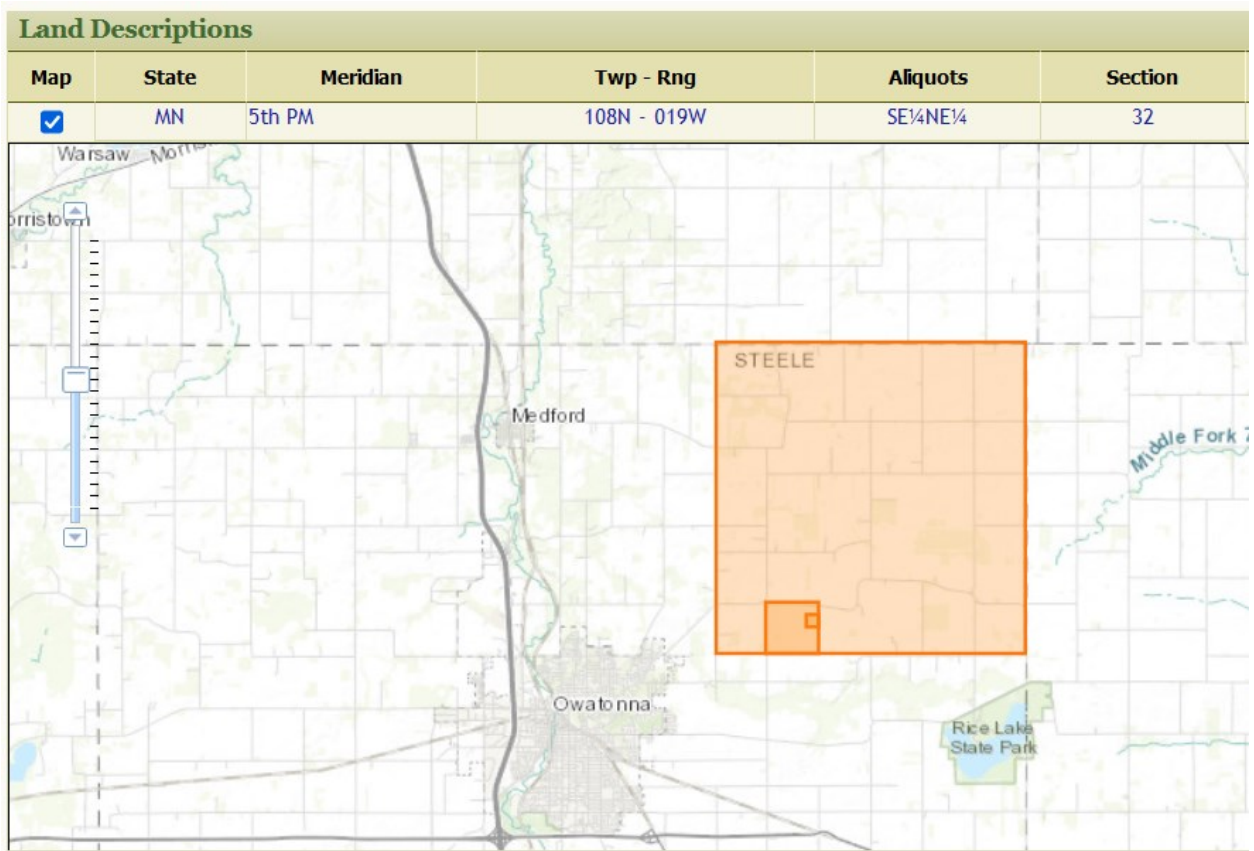
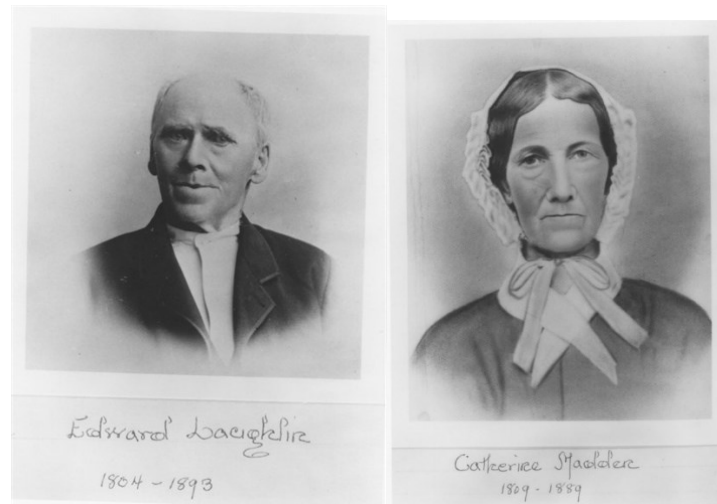


Figure 16: John Laughlin land record, for Merton township, Steele County, Minnesota, dated 4/10/1875 (April 10th):





Edward Laughlin & Catherine Madden

EDWARD LAUGHLIN & CATHERINE MADDEN

Edward was born April 16th in 1804 or 1812. (I saw a date of 16 Apr 1804 from County Cork or Tipperary being suggested on a member tree in FamilySearch, but I could find no source reference to why this date and place was listed.). I have found no correlating Laughlin families from Cork or Tipperary. The other Laughlin families who migrated together were from Galway. There is a chance, this Edward Laughlin is also from County Galway.

Edward emigrating from Pennsylvania to McHenry County, Illinois between 1844-1850 (his first son was born in Pennsylvania in 1843). There is an 1840 census for “Edward W Laughlin” in Wilkins, Allegheny, Pennsylvania, but I cannot confirm the ages. It only lists how many males and females per household and approximate ages – no names other than head of household.

Edward Laughlin Sr. married Catherine Madden between 1832-1842, likely in Ireland. They have the following known issue: John Henry (b. 1843 Pennsylvania), Margaret Jane (b. 1846 Alden, IL), Anne (b. 1849 Alden, IL), and Patrick (b. 1851 Alden, IL). The youngest, Patrick, died in infancy. There are likely more children prior to John Henry who were born but I have not found them on any records yet.

He first landed and lived in Pennsylvania in the early 1840s. Then then moves to Alden, McHenry, Illinois by 1846. He owns property in McHenry County in 1848, as shown by the aforementioned land records dated 1 Jun 1848 for Hartland Township in McHenry County, section 5 – which sits directly below Alden Township, sections 32 and 33, where the Madden families resides. The two families are connected. Edward lived in McHenry County the remainder of his life.

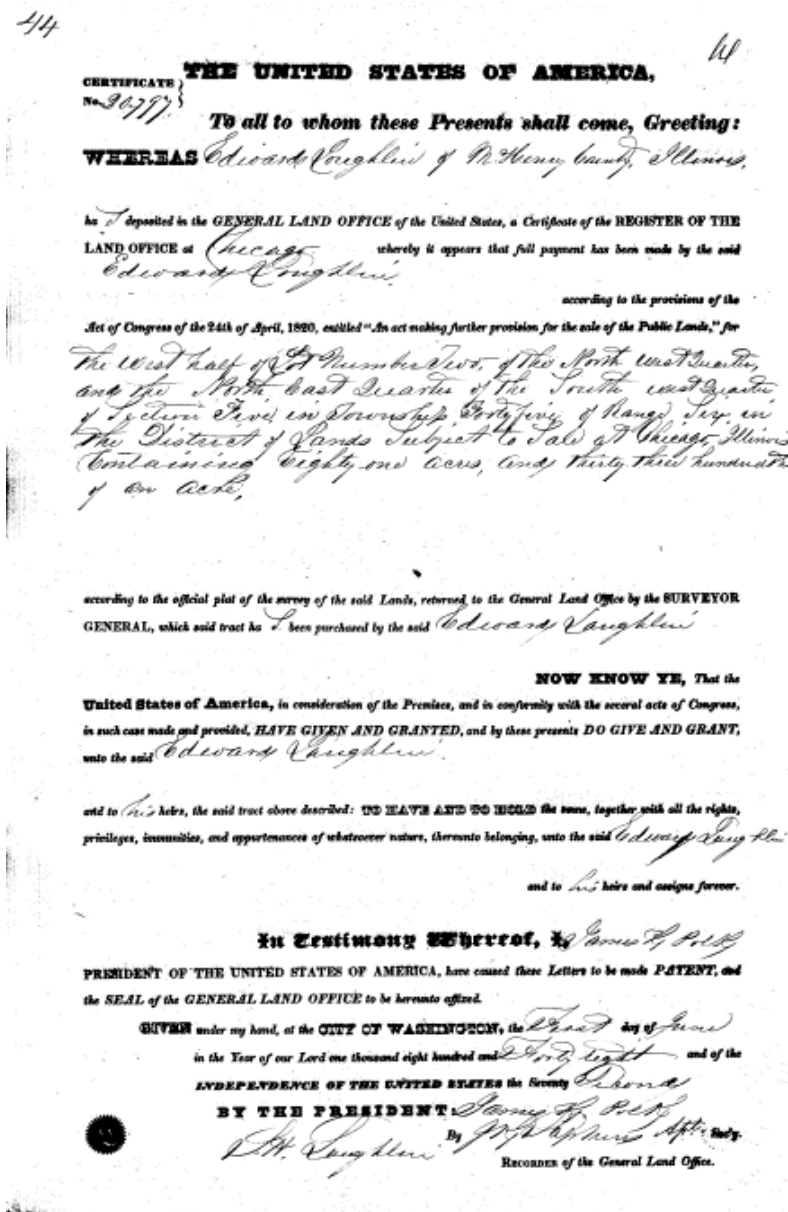

E. F. Laughlin, a hustling and progressive farmer of Merton township, Steele county—his birthplace—was born July 2, 1868. After receiving a good education in the district schools he immediately engaged in farming, first with his father and later for himself. He now owns a hundred and sixty acres of productive land, a hundred of which is tillable, the remaining sixty acres being used mostly for pasturage. In addition to general farming he carries on stock raising on an extensive scale, breeding and raising thoroughbred Percheron horses, Holstein cattle and Duroc Jersey hogs; also breeder of Scotch collie dogs. The use of modern buildings and machinery add to the profits of the place, a large up-to-date barn, forty by sixty-four, fourteen-foot post, comfortably housing all the stock. Mr. Laughlin also has a modern dwelling house. As to political convictions he is a Democrat and has always taken an active part in local affairs, having served as assessor during 1902 and 1903 and has been town clerk since 1905. He was married, in 1895, to Bertha A. Conlin, by whom he has six children: James A., Catherine L., Edward E., Mary E., Raymond P. and Lucile. John H., the father of our subject, is a native of Pennsylvania; his mother, Katie, (Conway) of Steele county, Minnesota. The father joined the Westward tide of emigration, in 1866, locating on his farm in Merton township, Steele county, where he still resides. Besides attending to the working of his farm he was a stock buyer for three years during his younger days. His good wife lives with him on the old place. Patrick and Mary (McGrath) Conlin, parents of Mrs. E. F. Laughlin, are old settlers of Minnesota, where the father carried on farming for many years. They are

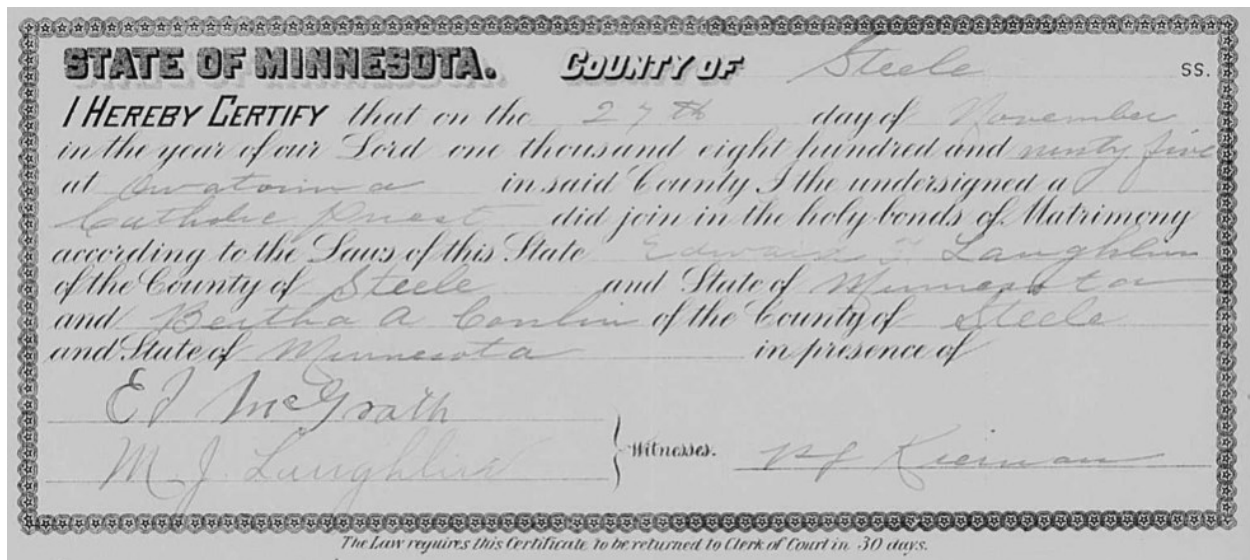

Edward F. Laughlin, 68 years old, died Sunday at 12:05 o'clock at his home on Owatonna Route 4. A heart attack resulted in death of the prominent farmer, a lifelong resident of Merton township, who for many years was prominent in county cooperative enterprises.

Born in Merton July 2, 1868, he was united in marriage November 27, 1894, and combined a lifelong occupation of farming with years of community service.
