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SUMMARY OF FINDINGS:

The research objective for this session has been met.

Robert Dawson b. 12 Jan 1821 St. Marylebone, Middlesex, England

Information and source documentation pertinent to Robert Dawson of St. Marylebone, Middlesex, England may be found in our email exchange per 22 Feb 2023 with appendages of his baptism and the 1952 Burke's Landed Gentry entry for his father and siblings, and half-siblings from his father's second marriage.

In the following report, I conclude the Robert Dawson b. 1821 Marylebone and the "Robert Dawsons" who immigrated to Perth County, Canada are not the same persons.

I believe the reason he was left out of the 1952 Burke's Landed Gentry, was he died in infancy. I found a few records for infant/child deaths in St. Marylebone, Middlesex, England in 26 February 1821, one month later than he would have been born. No parentage is listed on this burial record, however it does list the family lives on "New Street" of St. Marylebone. Age of child is simply written as "Chd" (child).

Robert Dawson b. 1817 Scotland and on the 1851 census in Blanchard, Perth, Ontario

These are my notes for Robert Dawson of Scotland and found on the 1851 census with wife Elizabeth and 2 children: James and Elizabeth.

Robert Dawson is buried in St. Mary's Cemetery, in St. Mary, Perth, Ontario. His wife was Elizabeth Steele, also of Scotland. She is buried with him. The dates given on the gravestone for them are Robert (1817-1857) and Elizabeth (1821-1903). Also in the same cemetery is the adjacent gravestone of their children James (1850-1866), Elizabeth (1857-1887), and Mary Ann (1853-1902). The birthdates for James and Elizabeth are difficult to read and these are what have been transcribed by others (I could not read the dates from the gravestone image). Because Elizabeth appears in the middle, I believe her birthdate may actually be between James and Mary Ann (1850-1853).

An additional son, Robert John Dawson (1851-1921) is with his wife Ida Maria Jickling, also in the St. Mary's cemetery. A marriage record for Robert John and Ida Maria was found 11 Jun 1918 in Blanchard, Perth, Ontario showing parentage of Robert Dawson and Elizabeth Steele. His death certificate also confirms these names.

Robert and Ann had four children living with them:

1. James Dawson (b. abt 1847 Blanchard, d. 1866 St. Mary's, Perth, Ontario)
2. Elizabeth Dawson (b. abt 1849 Blanchard, d. 1887 St. Mary's, Perth, Ontario)
3. Mary Ann Dawson (b. abt 1853 Blanchard, d. 1902 St. Mary's, Perth, Ontario)
4. Robert John Dawson (b. 17 Jun 1852 Blanchard, d. 5 Oct 1921 St. Mary's, Perth, Ontario)

Tax assessments as early as 1844 show the family living at Concession 15, Lot 14 in Blanchard, Perth, Ontario. I was able to see clearly just after this Robert Dawson of Scotland passed away, the land went to his widowed wife, Elizabeth Dawson. They lived at Concession 15, Lot 14 in Blanchard and are not the same family as the Robert H. Dawson living at Concession 15, Lot 19.

Robert Sr. died before the 1861 census. Elizabeth Dawson appears on the 1891 census in Blanchard, Perth, Ontario, widowed, and with children Robert (36) and Mary Ann (37). A niece Minnie (3) is also with them. Elizabeth's birthplace and parentage are all listed as Scotland. Elizabeth's daughter (also Elizabeth) died in 1887, so she is not appearing on this census with her siblings.

Robert and Elizabeth's religion was Presbyterian (Free Church), as it is shown on the 1851 census. This is matched on the 1891 census with Elizabeth.

Other censuses and documents may exist, however I stopped looking at this lineage with the death of Robert before the 1861 census and his heritage being of Scottish origin. **He is not a match to the Robert H. Dawson of Middlesex, England, nor a match for Robert H. Dawson of Blanchard Con 15, Lot 19 and we can rule him out.**

Robert H. Dawson b. 1 Oct 1819 England and on the 1861 census in Blanchard, Perth, Ontario and 1871 in St. Mary's, Perth, Ontario

These are my notes for Robert H. Dawson of England and found on the 1861 census with wife Ann Watson and children: George, Mary, John, Johana, and Richard. On this census, they are the only family on the page with a Frame house (vs. a Log house). Log houses are all 1 story, and their house was 1 ½ stories. Comparing this with the tax assessments, the family lived at Concession 15, Lot 19 and owned 124 acres in whole or in part throughout the years of 1855-1895.

Robert and Elizabeth had seven children living with them:

1. George Watson Dawson (b. 17 Dec 1850 Toronto, York, Ontario and d. 23 Aug 1940 Brantford, Brant, Ontario)
2. Mary Dawson (b. abt 1853 Ontario, Canada)
3. John Dawson (b. abt 1856, *poss* a twin, of Johanna)
4. Johanna Dawson (b. 1 Mar 1857 Ontario, d. 13 May 1937 at 178 Queen street, St. Mary's Perth, Ontario)
5. Richard W. Dawson (b. abt 1860 Ontario)
6. Joseph Dawson (b. abt 1864 Ontario)
7. Catherine "Kate" Schwartz – Dawson, adopted daughter (b. 14 Jul 1870 likely Germany, d. after 1911 St. Mary's, Perth, Ontario)

Noticing the birth year of the first born George, his death cert states he was born in 1850 Toronto. From 1851-1854 the family lived in Ontario, as shown by the births of his children.

The family moved to Blanchard by 1855, based on the tax assessments.

Robert's wife, Ann (nee Watson) Dawson, dies on 26 Jan 1911, St. Mary's, Perth, Ontario. She was born about 1828 Scotland. Her father is listed as Alexander Watson.

Robert dies on 31 May 1911 in St. Mary's, Perth, Ontario, just 4 months after his wife. He is shown as 91 Y and 8 M (putting his birthdate around Sep 1819). The 1901 census shows his birth date as 1 Oct 1819.

When comparing this to the baptismal and birth date of Robert Dawson, son of Rev. Henry Dawson – he was born and baptized 12 Jan 1821 England. This is a difference in both month and year. I am not convinced these two Robert's are the same.

A *possible* baptism for this Robert Dawson is 3 Oct 1819 at Appleby, Lincolnshire, England with parentage of George Dawson and Sarah. This might be plausible considering Robert H. Dawson's first born son is also named George. This would coincide with the birth of 1 Oct 1819 England.

Regarding Robert's death certificate: I concur the aforementioned Robert H. Dawson is the same person as this document supports. The informant (Miss) J Dawson is indeed his daughter, Johanna Dawson. She stayed single throughout her life and lived with her father up until the time of his death. This is supported through the presence of parents and daughter together on the 1861, 1871, 1881, 1891, and 1901 censuses. On the 1911 census she is living on Queen street with her sister, Kate (Swartz) Dawson and no parents. The parents have both deceased. Johanna d. 13 May 1937 still living on Queen street and is buried in the St. Mary's Cemetery. Her death certificate shows she is "single" supporting the above "(Miss)" in the informant on the father's death. On Johanna's death certificate, her mother's maiden name is Ann Watson and father is Robert H. Dawson.

Tax Assessments for all Robert Dawson (and var.) in Blanchard and St. Mary's, Perth, Ontario from 1843-1895

Through various tax assessments done between 1843 and 1857 for Blanshard, Huron, Canada West (Blanchard, Perth, Ontario – the counties of Huron and Perth become amalgamated), I found several Robert Dawson families, including Robert H. Dawson.

In 1857-1863, Robert H. Dawson is shown neighbouring and sharing a part of land on his Lot with Alexander Watson, the father of Ann Watson (Robert's wife), at Concession 15, Lot 19, totalling 124 acres between them. This matches the tax assessment for the previous years of 1855 and 1856 where Robert H. Dawson owns two Lots each of 100 acres of land: at Con 20, Lot 19 and at Con 15, Lot 19.

On the tax assessments for 1844, 1847, and 1848, there is a Robert Dawson with acreage at Con 15, Lot 14. He does not appear on the 1859 and 1865 tax assessment, but his wife does, as shown below, thus we can discern the person on those tax assessments is Robert Dawson of Scotland who died in 1857:

An 1859 tax assessment shows three Dawsons consecutively, all at different Concessions and Lots. The first, Elizabeth Dawson (Con 15, Lot 14) is the widow of Robert Dawson of Scotland, as he died a few years back in 1857. Next is Robert Dawson (Con 15, Lot 19, part – which matches other tax assessments as Robert H. Dawson). His age is shown as 40 years, putting his birth year at 1819. William Dawson follows (Con 16, Lot 9) at age 62.

An 1865 tax assessment shows several Dawsons including the widow Elizabeth Dawson at the top of the page at (Con 15, Lot 14). Down on the same page is Robert Dawson (at Con 15, Lot 19), William Dawson and John Dawson (sharing Con 16, Lot 9)

The Robert Dawson at Con 15, Lot 19 is Robert H. Dawson. He is sharing his land with James Sparling (unknown relation). This 1865 tax assessment also shows a Militia Roll. **Robert Dawson is listed as a Second Class Service under the Militia Roll, thus military service in 1865.** His age is listed as 45 and born abt 1820.

By the 1872 tax assessment we find Elizabeth Dawson (widow at Con 15, Lot 14), Robert H. Dawson (at Con 15, Lot 19, part – sharing with John Robinson, Christopher Robson and John Scott), and Neil Dawson

with John Dawson at (Con 16, Lots 9 and 10). On this tax assessment, the middle initial is shown for “Robert H. Dawson” thus matching other documents.

The family stays at Concession 15, Lot 19, owning a minimum of 100 acres, and sometimes both parts up to 124 acres from 1855-1895 confirmed with comparing tax assessments. In 1888, the address is now given as St. Mary’s on the Blanshard, Huron, Ontario tax assessment and the property is shown in the name of “G.W. Dawson” who is George Watson Dawson, Robert’s son. In 1895, the property is shown in the name of Robert Dawson again, also listed with the address of St. Mary’s and at Con 15, Lot 19.
